What is the King County Comprehensive Plan?

- **Over the next 20 years, the plan guides...**
 - Where population, housing, and jobs outside of cities go
 - How services are provided (buses, parks, solid waste, wastewater, etc.)
 - **Through assigning local land use & zoning, the plan determines...**
 - What uses are allowed on lands outside cities (homes, offices, stores, etc.)
 - **Impacts to current and future generations include...**
 - Access to determinants of equity
 - Quality of neighborhoods
 - Clean water, clean air, and healthy environments
 - Working farming and forests
