What is the King County Comprehensive Plan?

- Over the next 20 years, the plan guides...
 - o Where population, housing, and jobs outside of cities go
 - o How services are provided (buses, parks, solid waste, wastewater, etc.)
- Through assigning local land use & zoning, the plan determines...
 - o What uses are allowed on lands outside cities (homes, offices, stores, etc.)
- Impacts to current and future generations include...
 - o Access to determinants of equity
 - o Quality of neighborhoods
 - o Clean water, clean air, and healthy environments
 - o Working farming and forests


2024 Update
