1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2020-0403, VERSION 1**

2 On page 4, line 66, after "services." insert "The office of equity and social justice shall
3 consult with county employees who identify as Native American and with tribes located
4 within King County on whether October 12 is the preferred date to designate the
5 Indigenous Peoples' Day holiday with pay. After consulting with those employees and
6 tribes located within King County, if the office determines that a different date is more
7 appropriate to designate Indigenous Peoples' Day, then the office shall transmit necessary
8 legislation to change the October 12 date to the council before December 31, 2021."

10 On page 4, line 67, after "SECTION 3." strike "This ordinance takes effect January 1,
11 2022" and insert: "Section 1. of this ordinance takes effect January 1, 2022. Section 2. of
12 this ordinance takes effect January 1, 2021."

14 ***EFFECT: Requires the Office of Equity and Social Justice to consult with Native***
15 ***American county employees and tribes regarding the appropriate date for celebration***
16 ***of Indigenous Peoples' Day; if, after such consultation, OESJ determines that a***
17 ***different date is more appropriate, it will transmit legislation to accomplish that change***
18 ***before December 31, 2021. Section 2 of the ordinance, containing these requirements***

19 *for consultation, takes effect on January 1, 2021; Section 1 takes effect on January 1,*
20 *2022.*
