Proposed No. 2002-0298.1 Sponsors Constantine 1 AN ORDINANCE authorizing the sale of one parcel of 2 surplus county-owned real property, located in council 3 district 8, and two parcels of tax title property, located in 4 council districts 3 and 12, respectively. 5 6 7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: 8 SECTION 1. Findings of fact. 9 A. King County owns a parcel of property on Vashon that was acquired by the 10 current expense fund as a result of a trade with the state of Washington in 1980. The 11 property has never been utilized by King County. 12 B. The department of executive services, facilities management division, has 13 declared the subject parcel surplus to its needs. 14 C. Notices were sent to county departments and none expressed an interest in 15 the property. 16 D. The Vashon water district, fire district, school district and community council 17 were notified regarding the county's plan to surplus and sell the property. The Vashon

18	water district expressed a preliminary interest before the county's completion of an			
19	appraisal establishing the fair market value.			
20	E. King County holds in trust two parcels of surplus "tax title" property located in			
21	eastern King County.			
22	F. King County acquired the subject properties in 2001 as a result of the			
23	December 2000 foreclosure sale for delinquent real property taxes. The properties are			
24	held in trust until such time as they are sold.			
25	G. The facilities management division finds the three properties surplus to the			
26	county's present and foreseeable needs.			
27	H. The three parcels have no sewer available at this time; therefore they are not			
28	suitable for affordable housing under the Growth Management Act.			
29	I. Under K.C.C. chapter 4.56, when no county department or governmental			
30	agency has expressed a need for surplus real property and the property does not meet the			
31	criteria for affordable housing, the property may be offered for sale by public sealed bid.			
32	SECTION 2	The King County executive is hereby auth	orized to execute the	
33	necessary documents to sell the following described properties to the successful			
34	purchasers. The parcels will be offered for sale by public sealed bid with the asking price			
35	within range of the below-stated appraised values. The actual sales price shall be deemed			
36	"acceptable" based on the asking price established at the time of sale. King County			
37	reserves the right to reject any and all offers.
