Please allow sufficient time in advance of the hearing start time to navigate traffic, find parking in busy downtown, and to move through Courthouse security. Situate within the Southwest Quarter of Section 13, Township 23, North, Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian, King County, Washington. Containing 3,073 square feet, more or less.
