The entire bequest totals approximately \$390,000 and will be held in the County Trust and Contribution fund. A total of \$360,000 will be disbursed to King County in 2002, with the balance of the estate totaling approximately \$30,000 - \$40,000 disbursed in early 2003. As expenditures are incurred by transit, the bequest will be drawn down until it is depleted.

It is expected that funds from the bequest will be used to provide additional weekday door-to-door van service via the South Seattle Shuttle and a weekday special needs transportation hotline staffed with travel advocates for senior citizens and people with disabilities.
