1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the department of executive  
2 services; authorizing the director of executive services or  
3 designee to execute an interlocal agreement with the city of  
4 Seattle to regulate for-hire transportation.

5 STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 6 1. Due to changes in state law governing the regulation of transportation  
7 network companies, modifying an existing King County Code chapter that  
8 regulates transportation network companies and establishing a new King  
9 County Code chapter to regulate taxicabs and for-hire vehicles best  
10 articulates the county's objectives for that industry.
- 11 2. The county partners with the city of Seattle through an interlocal  
12 agreement to regulate the for-hire transportation industry and desires to  
13 maintain that partnership under common regulations in the future.
- 14 3. The county and the city of Seattle last updated the interlocal agreement  
15 concerning for-hire transportation in August 1995.

16 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

17 SECTION 1. The director of the department of executive services, or designee, is  
18 authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement for For-Hire Transportation with the city  
19 of Seattle, which is Attachment A to this ordinance.

20 SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect and be in force thirty days after its

- 21 enactment, but if not approved and returned by the executive within ten days after  
22 presentation, this ordinance takes effect as provided in the King County Charter.
