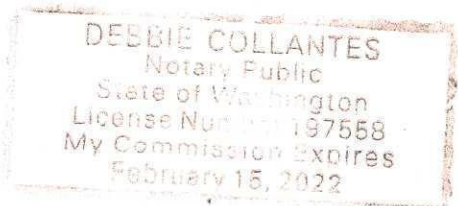

### METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF ADOPTION

Ordinance 19282

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing on Tuesday, April 27, 2021, beginning at 1:00 P.M. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2021-0105, adding a new section to King County Code 21A.16, relating to exterior lighting fixtures within the R1-B zones. The Council adopted the legislation at that meeting.

**SUMMARY:**  
Ordinance 19282 adds a new section to King County Code Chapter 21A.16 that would require all exterior lighting fixtures in the R1-B zones be installed and maintained so that light from the fixture is not directed toward windows or buildings on adjacent residential properties.

Ordinance 19282**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing on Tuesday, April 27, 2021, beginning at 1:00 P.M. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2020-0024, adopting amendments to King County Code 13.24.035 related to sewer service eligibility in the Vashon and Snoqualmie Pass rural towns. The Council adopted the legislation at that meeting.

**SUMMARY:**

The Washington State Growth Management Act (GMA) tightly restricts provision of sewer service outside the Urban Growth Area boundary. While all of Vashon-Maury Island is located outside of the Urban Growth Area and is considered rural in nature, the King County Comprehensive Plan and King County Code recognize concentrations of higher density and economic activity in the Rural Area that existed prior to the adoption of the Growth Management Act by allowing rural towns, such as the Vashon Rural Town and the Snoqualmie Pass Rural Town, to have urban-style levels of density and development, including sewer.

Ordinance 19282 amends Title 13 to clarify that expanding the area eligible for sewer service within the Vashon Rural Town requires a separate and distinct action from changing the Vashon Rural Town boundary, and that the Snoqualmie Pass Rural Town is also approved for sewer service. The legislation also clarifies that the Snoqualmie Pass Rural Town has also been approved for sewer service and must only provide sewer service to areas within the Rural Town boundary.
