Seattle Sports Commission Owned Events

- **SSC Open** brings together a group of high-level executives and sport supporters for a scramble format golf tournament and day of networking.(September 25, 2018)

The SSC works with Seattle's decision-makers to bid on events like NCAA Final Four, FIFA World Cup, Collegiate Boxing, and the opportunity to launch new franchise teams like the Seattle Seawolves.

Sports For All: 2018 Special Olympics USA Games

- From July 1-6, 2018, more than 4,000 athletes and coaches representing 50 states competed in 14 Olympic-style team and individual sports in Seattle.
- The Seattle Sports Commission assisted with the efforts to bring the Special Olympics USA Games to Seattle and looks forward to hosting again in the future!

FIFA United Bid 2026

- For over 10 years, the SSC has been working with regional businesses, local government and various organizations in an effort to bring the World Cup to Seattle.
- Seattle is in the running to be selected as one of the 16 World Cup host cities, a process that involves long-term collaborative efforts and a strong proposal.

Seawolves Win MLR Championship in Inaugural Season

- The Seattle Seawolves sold out of season tickets in both its inaugural (2018) and sophomore (2019) seasons.
- The Seawolves' success has grown local interest in rugby and adds another professional franchise championship victory to Seattle's count.
