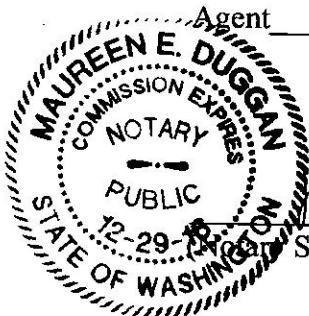

Ordinance 17914

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council adopted Ordinance 17914 on November 3, 2014. King County provides this notice of adoption and enactment pursuant to RCW 36.70A.290(2)(b).

SUMMARY

Ordinance 17914 relates to the King County transportation concurrency management program. The concurrency map is a tool for ensuring that King County's transportation infrastructure is adequate to meet the needs of new development. The concurrency map identifies which travel sheds throughout unincorporated King County pass or fail the concurrency test, as measured by travel time standards applied to each travel shed. A proposed development must be in a passing travel shed as an initial step in the project development process. Ordinance 17914 amends King County Code 14.70.270 to change the schedule for updating the concurrency map. The new schedule provides for updates in even numbered years, with transmittal of a report and, if needed, a new concurrency map to the County Council by July 31 of a transmittal year.
