1 AN ORDINANCE approving the city of Renton
2 Comprehensive Water System Plan.

5 PREAMBLE:

6 K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water
7 utilities as a prerequisite for granting right-of-way franchises and approval
8 of right-of-way construction permits.

9 RCW 43.20.260 requires that water system plans for any new industrial,
10 commercial, or residential use are to be consistent with the requirements
11 of any comprehensive plans or development regulations adopted under
12 chapter 36.70A RCW or any other applicable comprehensive plan, land
13 use plan, or development regulation adopted by a city, town or county for
14 the service area.

15 The city of Renton currently provides water service to approximately
16 50,000 residents and commercial/industrial water users. The city is
17 located in the south portion of King County.

18 The city of Renton obtains its water from local aquifers. The average
19 annual water demand is currently 7.7 million gallons per day. The
20 demand is projected to increase to about 11 million gallons per day in
21 2025, assuming a small reduction as a result of the city's planned water
22 conservation program.

23 The city of Renton is planning a five-year capital improvement program
24 valued at nearly \$21,500,000. The capital improvements proposed include
25 modifications to the city's water storage and distribution systems.

26 The city of Renton is within the geographic area covered by the East King
27 Coordinated Water Supply Plan ("CWSP"), which was last updated in
28 1998. Water system plans for utilities within that area must be consistent
29 with the CWSP. The CWSP may be updated to reflect current information
30 and conditions as part of the King County regional water supply plan, for
31 which a planning process was approved by a multi-stakeholder Scoping
32 Committee on October 31, 2005.

33 The King County utilities technical review committee ("UTRC") reviewed
34 and conditionally approved the city of Renton water system plan on March
35 16, 2005. The conditions of approval have been met by changes that have
36 been incorporated into the revised plan, copies of which are attached to
37 this ordinance. The UTRC recommends that the council approve the plan.

38 The plan must also be reviewed and approved by the Washington
39 Department of Health.

40 A determination of non-significance for the plan was issued by the city of
41 Renton on November 10, 2004, in accordance with the state
42 Environmental Policy Act.

43 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

44 SECTION 1. The City of Renton Comprehensive Water System Plan,

45 Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved without conditions.




