Dear Councilmember Upthegrove:

This letter transmits a proposed Ordinance that, if enacted, would approve the City of Enumclaw Water Comprehensive Plan dated February 2024 (plan). This letter and enclosed matrix describe the results of the Utilities Technical Review Committee's (UTRC) review of the plan and its consistency with King County requirements.

The Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 70A.100.050 and King County Code (KCC)13.24 require King County approval of the plan before it becomes effective. Approval of the plan also provides state regulatory agencies with the determination required under RCW 43.20.260 that the plan is consistent with the King County Comprehensive Plan and implementing development regulations.

The UTRC has reviewed the plan for conformance with KCC. It recommended its approval on March 20, 2024.

The enclosed matrix provides additional information regarding the City's plan and compliance with KCC requirements and consistency with the King County Comprehensive Plan.

I appreciate the City's cooperation in submitting the plan and working through the UTRC review process.
