Dear Councilmember Upthegrove:

This letter transmits a proposed Ordinance that, if enacted, would approve Harborview Medical Center's (HMC) annual capital improvement program budget for the 2025 fiscal year, covering \$29.2 million for projects to improve service delivery and maintain facility infrastructure.

Each year the Harborview Board of Trustees recommends an annual capital budget which is submitted to the King County Executive for review prior to transmittal to the King County Council. The Trustees approved this proposed budget in February 2024.

The primary capital improvement projects funded are the Ninth and Jefferson Building operating rooms and the Maleng Building single patient room project. The proposed budget is supported by using transfers from the HMC operating revenue; it does not utilize voterapproved bond financing.
