6 **STATEMENT OF THE FACTS:**

- 7 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of George
8 G. Bayne Road hereinafter described.
- 9 2. The department of transportation notified the various utility companies
10 serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required
11 within the vacation area.
- 12 3. The department of transportation records indicates that King County
13 has not been maintaining George G. Bayne Road. The records indicate
14 that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition.
- 15 4. The department of transportation considers the subject portion of the
16 right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the

17 public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax
18 rolls.

19 5. The right-of-way is classified as "C-Class" and, in accordance with
20 K.C.C. 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty
21 percent of the assessed value of the subject right-of-way, which was
22 determined from records of the department of assessments. King County
23 is in receipt of \$2,399.38 from Lake Retreat Camp & Conference Center
24 and \$2,077.23 from V. G. Vaden.

25 Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was
26 held by the office of the hearing examiner on the 2nd day of June, 2003.
27 In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation,
28 the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of
29 King County to grant said petition.

30 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

31 SECTION 1. The council, on the 7th day of July, 2003, hereby vacates and
32 abandons that portion of George G. Bayne Road as conveyed to King County by quit-
33 claim deed recorded in Volume 1206 of Deeds, Page 295, records of King County,
34 Washington described as follows:





DEPARTMENT'S REPORT:

The Department of Transportation's written report to the King County Hearing Examiner for Item No. V-2445 was received by the Examiner on May 5, 2003.

PUBLIC HEARING:

After reviewing the Department of Transportation's Report and examining available information on file with the petition, the Examiner conducted a public hearing on the subject as follows:

The hearing on Item no. V-2445 was opened by the Examiner at 1:02 p.m. on June 2, 2003, in the Union Bank of California fifth-floor conference room, 900 4th Avenue, Seattle, Washington, and closed at 1:13 p.m. Participants at the public hearing and the exhibits offered and entered are listed in the attached minutes. A verbatim recording of the hearing is available in the office of the King County Hearing Examiner.

FINDINGS, CONCLUSIONS & RECOMMENDATION: Having reviewed the record in this matter, the Examiner now makes and enters the following:

FINDINGS:

1. General Information:

Road name and location:	Portion of George G. Bayne Road east of Ravensdale Thomas bros. page 718, J7
Right of way classification:	"C"
Area:	15,203 square feet
Compensation:	\$2,399.38 for Lake Retreat Camp & Conference Center \$2,077.23 for V. G. Vaden

2. Except as provided below, the Examiner adopts and incorporates herein by this reference the facts set forth in the Department of Transportation's report to the King County Hearing Examiner for the June 4, 2003, public hearing and the statement of facts contained in Proposed Ordinance No. 2003-0183. The Department's report will be attached to those copies of this report and recommendation that are submitted to the Metropolitan King County Council.
3. Maps showing the vicinity of the proposed vacation and the specific area to be vacated are Attachments 1 and 2 to this Report and Recommendation.
4. Vacation of the subject right-of-way would have no adverse effect on the provision of fire and emergency services to the subject property or surrounding area.

CONCLUSIONS:

1. The road subject to this petition is useless as part of the King County road system, and the public will be benefited by its vacation.
2. The Notice of Hearing on the report of the Department of Transportation was given as required

by law, and a hearing on the report was conducted by the King County Hearing Examiner on behalf of the King County Council.

- 3. The compensation required by law to be paid as a condition precedent to the vacation of this road has been deposited with King County, and the easements, if any, necessary for the construction, repair and maintenance of public utilities and services have been provided in form satisfactory to the affected public utilities.

RECOMMENDATION:

APPROVE proposed Ordinance No. 2003-0183 to vacate the subject road.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL
AND ADDITIONAL ACTION REQUIRED

In order to appeal the recommendation of the Examiner, written notice of appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council with a fee of \$250.00 (check payable to King County Office of Finance) *on or before June 25, 2003*. If a notice of appeal is filed, the original and 6 copies of a written appeal statement specifying the basis for the appeal and argument in support of the appeal must be filed with the Clerk of the King County Council *on or before July 2, 2003*.

Filing requires actual delivery to the Office of the Clerk of the Council, Room 1025, King County Courthouse, 516 3rd Avenue, Seattle, Washington 98104, prior to the close of business (4:30 p.m.) on the date due. Prior mailing is not sufficient if actual receipt by the Clerk does not occur within the applicable time period. The Examiner does not have authority to extend the time period unless the Office of the Clerk is not open on the specified closing date, in which event delivery prior to the close of

business on the next business day is sufficient to meet the filing requirement.

If a written notice of appeal and filing fee are not filed within 14 days calendar days of the date of this report, or if a written appeal statement and argument are not filed within 21 calendar days of the date of this report, the Clerk of the Council shall place a proposed ordinance which implements the Examiner's recommended action on the agenda of the next available Council meeting. At that meeting, the Council may adopt the Examiner's recommendation, may defer action, may refer the matter to a Council committee, or may remand to the Examiner for further hearing or further consideration.

Action of the Council Final. The action of the Council on a recommendation of the Examiner shall be final and conclusive unless within twenty-one (21) days from the date of the action an aggrieved party or person applies for a writ of certiorari from the Superior Court in and for the County of King, State of Washington, for the purpose of review of the action taken.

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
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
