3 On page 1, beginning on line 6, strike everything through page 2, line 21, and insert:

4 "BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 **SECTION 1. Findings:**

6 A. King County and the King County Flood Control Zone District have entered  
7 into the Interlocal Agreement Between King County and the King County Flood Control  
8 Zone District Regarding Flood Protection Services, effective January 1, 2016.

9 B. The county and the district desire to amend the interlocal agreement to extend  
10 its term from December 31, 2018 to December 31, 2019.

11 C. The first amendment to the interlocal agreement, Attachment A to this  
12 ordinance, amends the interlocal agreement to extend its term through December 31,  
13 2019.

14 D. Immediate approval of the amendment to the interlocal agreement is necessary  
15 so that the county can continue to provide flood protection services and to implement the  
16 district's work plan for the year 2019.

17 **SECTION 2.** The county executive is hereby authorized to execute an amendment  
18 to the Interlocal Agreement Between King County and the King County Flood Control

19 Zone District Regarding Flood Protection Services, substantially in the form of  
20 Attachment A to this ordinance. All other provisions of the interlocal agreement shall  
21 remain in full force and effect.

22 SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency  
23 exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace,  
24 health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public  
25 institutions."

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO  
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
KING COUNTY AND THE KING COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT  
REGARDING FLOOD PROTECTION SERVICES**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to the "Interlocal Agreement between King County and the King County Flood Control Zone District Regarding Flood Protection Services" ("Agreement"), is entered into by KING COUNTY, a home rule charter County in the State of Washington ("County") and KING COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT, a quasi-municipal corporation of the State of Washington ("District"), and shall be effective upon execution by both Parties.

The Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. The text of Section 13.1 is deleted and replaced with the following:

This Agreement shall take effect January 1, 2016 and shall remain in effect through December 31, 2019.

All other terms of the Agreement not amended by this First Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
