1 A MOTION making an appointment of Raul Martinez to
2 fill a judicial vacancy in the shoreline division, shoreline
3 electoral district, judge position number one of the King
4 County district court.

5 WHEREAS, a judicial vacancy exists in the Shoreline division, Shoreline
6 electoral district, judge position number one of the King County district court, and

7 WHEREAS, RCW 3.34.100 authorizes the county legislative body to fill judicial
8 vacancies in district court, and

9 WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 2.70 provides for the metropolitan King County
10 council to fill judicial vacancies in district court, and

11 WHEREAS, in accordance with K.C.C. 2.70.020.D., candidates must have a
12 current rating of, at a minimum, "qualified" for a district court judicial position from the
13 King County Bar Association and at least one other bar association operating in King
14 County with an eligible judicial candidate evaluation process, and

15 WHEREAS, a rating of the King County Bar Association is valid for three years,
16 and

17 WHEREAS, for those eligible candidates, the committee of the whole reviewed
18 candidate ratings from the King County Bar Association and other bar associations with
19 an established judicial candidate evaluation procedure, reviewed written materials

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20 concerning each candidate and conducted interviews with the final candidates in
21 accordance with K.C.C. chapter 2.70, and

22 WHEREAS, the council has carefully considered the qualifications of the final
23 candidates;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

25 Raul Martinez is hereby appointed to fill the judicial vacancy in the Shoreline

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- 26 division, Shoreline electoral district, judge position number one of the King County
27 district court.

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
