1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2018-0375, VERSION 2**

2 Beginning on page 6, strike lines 119 through line 122 and insert:

3 **"NEW SECTION. SECTION 5.** There is hereby added to K.C.C. chapter 10.25 a  
4 new section to read as follows:

5 The solid waste division shall report to the council annually on progress in  
6 establishing and maintaining the buffer as required by policy D-5 in chapter six of the  
7 2019 Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan, with the first report filed no later  
8 than April 1, 2020. Reports shall be filed in the form of a paper original and an electronic  
9 copy with the clerk of the council, who shall retain the original and provide an electronic  
10 copy to all councilmembers, the council chief of staff and the lead staff to the committee  
11 of the whole or its successor.

12 **SECTION 6.** Sections 1 through 5 of this ordinance take effect forty-five days  
13 after the solid waste division transmits the 2019 Comprehensive Solid Waste  
14 Management Plan to the Washington state Department of Ecology, unless the  
15 Washington state Department of Ecology disapproves the plan."

16

17 In Attachment A, on page Att A Page 15, in the last paragraph, after "To meet disposal  
18 needs, this Plan recommends further development of Cedar Hills to maximize disposal capacity" insert ",

19 while affirming that garbage shall not be disposed of, nor shall soils be stockpiled, within 1,000 feet of the  
20 property line at the landfill, in accordance with the Settlement Agreement"

21

22 In Attachment A, on page Att A Page 155, after

23 "D-4 Plan for future disposal when Cedar Hills Regional Landfill closes to ensure no gap in  
24 service. Siting a replacement landfill located in King County will not be considered."

25 insert:

26 "  
27 D-5 Garbage shall not be disposed of, nor shall soils be stockpiled, within 1,000 feet of the  
28 property line at the landfill, in accordance with the Settlement Agreement. The solid  
29 waste division shall reserve sufficient funds to acquire any parcels from willing sellers as  
30 necessary to establish or maintain the buffer."  
31

32 In Attachment A, on page Att A Page 159, in the last paragraph, after "It maximizes the use  
33 of readily available space at the landfill, with the least amount of disruption to existing landfill structures"  
34 strike "and the buffer" and insert ". Garbage shall not be disposed of, nor soils be stockpiled, within  
35 1,000 feet of the property line at the landfill, in accordance with the Settlement Agreement"

36

37 In Attachment A, on page Att A Page 161, in the second paragraph of the section entitled  
38 "Further Development of Cedar Hills is Recommended" after "This recommendation will further develop  
39 Cedar Hills to maximize disposal capacity, extending the division's over 50-year practice of managing its  
40 waste locally. The increased capacity" strike "will not encroach the buffer" and insert "shall not all  
41 result in either disposal of garbage or stockpiling of soils within 1,000 feet of the property line at the  
42 landfill, in accordance with the Settlement Agreement"

43

44 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any internal  
45 references accordingly.

46 Upon adoption of any amendments, the clerk of the council is directed to engross  
47 all of the changes made to and update the header of Attachment A to reflect the  
48 date of action.

49

50 **EFFECT: This amendment would reaffirm the county's agreement to not dispose of**  
51 **garbage or stockpile soils within 1,000 feet of the property line at the landfill, in**  
52 **accordance with the Settlement Agreement. Specifically, it would:**

- 53 • *Require the division to acquire parcels from willing sellers as necessary to*  
54 *maintain the 1,000-foot buffer;*
- 55 • *Report by April 1 each year on progress in establishing and maintaining the*  
56 *buffer;*
- 57 • *Add a policy (D-5) in Attachment A on page 155 stating that Garbage shall not*  
58 *be disposed nor soils stockpiled within 1,000 feet of the property line at the*  
59 *landfill, in accordance with the Settlement Agreement, and add language on*  
60 *pages 15, 159 and 161 restating the 1,000-foot buffer agreement and*  
61 *strengthening language such that the increased capacity will not result in*  
62 *disposing of garbage or stockpiling of soil with the 1000-foot buffer."*

- 14 • An inventory of birds at least seagull-sized or larger that inhabit the Cedar Hills Regional Landfill,  
15 including species and number of birds, to be updated annually;
- 16 • Design suggestions to minimize attractiveness of the site to birds;  
17  
18 A description of proposed bird control methods including equipment, construction activities,  
19 permits required (including federal and state fish and wildlife permits), and other operation and  
20 maintenance requirements related to bird control;
- 21 • Description of staff resources and training needed to implement the control plan thoroughly and  
22 completely;
- 23 • Description of staff resources and training needed to implement the control plan thoroughly and  
24 completely;
- 25

- 26       • Performance metrics related to bird management; and
- 27
- 28       • A monitoring plan to, on at least an annual basis, assess the efficacy of the bird management
- 29       plan and allow further adaptation and improvement of the plan. It will also provide a basis for
- 30       determining if bird use of the area changes through time."
- 31

32       Renumber sections consecutively and correct internal references accordingly.

33       Upon adoption of any amendments, the clerk of the council is directed to engross

34       all of the changes made to and update the header of Attachment A to reflect the

35       date of action.
