Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:37 p.m.

The committee received a briefing on the work plan and discussed a timeline. The committee also received a briefing on the Executive's child health initiative.

Mr. Phillips reported on the Cedar River Council. The Council received a report on the health of the Cedar River, and discussed the November flood management issues. The Council also adopted its 2007-2008 work plan.

Mr. Phillips briefed the Council on the 4Culture board meeting. The Board reviewed program highlights, such as the 4Culture Gallery and historic preservation, and reviewed the 2007 heritage facility funding recommendations. The Board also reviewed its 2007 work program and plan. There was great discussion regarding the legislative update on the need for continued hotel/motel tax funding in the future.
