### METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF ADOPTION Ordinance 18481

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Avenue, Seattle, WA) on Monday, March 27, 2017, beginning at 1:30 PM. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2017-0009 (Ordinance 18481) an ordinance relating to the County's stormwater and surface water regulations.

#### SUMMARY:

Ordinance 18481 amends the regulations pertaining to the County's enforcement criteria for water quality violations. Specifically, the Ordinance establishes the criteria for determining the amount of civil penalties that may be assessed on a responsible party for a water quality violation.
