NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council will hold a public hearing in the King County Council Chambers, 10th Floor, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington on Monday November 5, 2018 at 11:30 a.m. The purpose of this hearing is to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance No. 2018-0465, which will adopt the 2019-2020 King County Capital Improvement Program (CIP). The CIP becomes the capital facilities component of the King County Comprehensive Plan and is adopted as an amendment to the King County Comprehensive Plan. The 2019-2024 King County CIP, as adopted by the County Council, will satisfy the Growth Management Act requirement to provide a six-year plan that will finance capital facilities within projected funding capacities and clearly identify sources of public money for those capital facilities.

SUMMARY

The CIP budget for the 2019-2020 biennium is \$1.92 billion. Of the \$1.92 billion proposed to be budgeted for 2019-2020, \$683 million is for the Wastewater Treatment capital program, \$336 million is proposed for Public Transportation capital program, and \$179 million is bus and van pool vehicle replacement.
