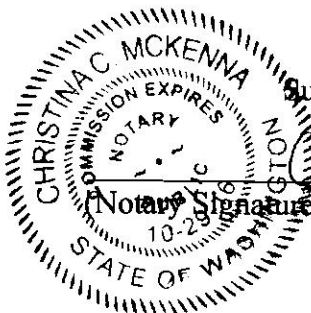

Proposed Ordinance 2014-0168

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, on the 2nd day of June, 2014 at 10:00 AM, at the Renton City Hall, 1055 S. Grady Way, Renton, WA 98057, to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2014-0168.

Proposed Ordinance 2014-0168 does the following:

- Makes a determination of the sewer rate for the year 2015 that must be charged in order to meet the monetary requirements (administration, operating, and maintenance, repair and replacement costs) of the County's sewage disposal program. The proposed sewer rate for 2015 is \$42.03 per month per residential customer equivalent (RCE). By comparison, the 2014 rate is \$39.79 per month per RCE.

- Sets the capacity charge for sewer connections occurring between and including January 1, 2015 and December 31, 2015. The capacity charge is the fee that is assessed against customers establishing new connections to ensure that those customers bear their equitable share of the cost of new capacity-related sewage facilities necessary to serve them. The proposed capacity charge is \$57.00 per month per RCE for fifteen years. By comparison, the 2014 capacity charge is \$55.35 per RCE per month for fifteen years.
