1 AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive
2 to execute an amendment to the interlocal agreement with
3 the King County flood control zone district extending the
4 duration of the interlocal agreement; and declaring an
5 emergency.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Findings:

8 A. King County and the King County Flood Control Zone District ("the district")
9 entered into the interlocal agreement regarding flood protection services, effective
10 January 1, 2016.

11 B. The county enacted Ordinance 18854 to extend the term of the interlocal
12 agreement with the district from December 31, 2018, to December 31, 2019.

13 C. The county and the district desire to continue to operate under the terms of the
14 interlocal agreement until a new one can be negotiated and adopted. To that end, and to
15 preserve the status quo, it is expected that the district's board of supervisors intend to
16 meet on December 11, 2019 to authorize a second amendment to the interlocal
17 agreement, substantially similar to Attachment A to this ordinance, to extend the term of
18 the current 2016 interlocal agreement. As acknowledged by the county executive in the
19 executive's December 4, 2019, letter to the district's board chair, a target date for

20 completion of the negotiations on a new interlocal agreement is not until late in the first
21 quarter of 2020.

22 D. The second amendment to the interlocal agreement, Attachment A to this
23 ordinance, amends the interlocal agreement to extend its term to a mutually agreeable
24 date certain but not to exceed December 31, 2020, in order to ensure the parties enough
25 time to negotiate the new interlocal agreement and have it adopted by both parties.

26 E. Extending the current interlocal agreement is necessary for the immediate
27 preservation of the parties' ability to continue, without disruption, to provide flood
28 management/protection services, which will preserve the health and safety of the
29 residents of King County and help protect them from the ravages of flooding.

30 SECTION 2. The council supports, and authorizes the executive to execute an
31 amendment to the Interlocal Agreement Between King County and the King County
32 Flood Control Zone District Regarding Flood Protection Services substantially in the
33 form of Attachment A to this ordinance. The council authorizes the executive to
34 negotiate with the district for the term of the extension, which should not exceed the date
35 of December 31, 2020.

36 SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency
37 exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace,

38 health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public
39 institutions.

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
KING COUNTY AND THE KING COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT
REGARDING FLOOD PROTECTION SERVICES**

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT to the "Interlocal Agreement between King County and the King County Flood Control Zone District Regarding Flood Protection Services" ("Agreement"), is entered into by KING COUNTY, a home rule charter County in the State of Washington ("County") and KING COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT, a quasi-municipal corporation of the State of Washington ("District"), and shall be effective upon execution by both Parties.

The Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. The text of Section 13.1 is deleted and replaced with the following:

This Agreement shall take effect January 1, 2016 and shall remain in effect through _____.

All other terms of the Agreement not amended by this Second Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
