The area to be vacated is described as follows: All that portion of 314th Way Southeast dedicated as Railroad Avenue as shown on the Plat of the Townsite of Cumberland, abutting and adjacent to the properties located at 35510 Veazie-Cumberland Rd SE, being tax lot number 1871400195, otherwise known as Lots 13 and 14 of said Plat of the Townsite of Cumberland, recorded in Volume 19 of Plats, page 52, records of King County, Washington.
