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Our Programs

Trade, Travel, Air Cargo, Maritime and Logistics

- Port Jobs works as an intermediary to build trade, travel, air cargo, maritime and logistics partnerships that anticipate and respond to the hiring and training needs of employers.
- We prepare job seekers and incumbent workers for exciting careers through our programs, partnerships and training opportunities.

Airport Jobs

- In partnership with the Port of Seattle, Port Jobs operates Airport Jobs as the primary recruiting source for Sea-Tac employers, providing businesses with a single point of contact for recruiting, interviewing, and hiring assistance.
- Airport Jobs provides services, technology and resources that job seekers need to advance in their careers. Each year, thousands visit our Sea-Tac office to receive personalized job-seeking assistance, and another 123,000 visit our Jobs Hotlist, updated daily at airportjobs.org.

Airport University

- Airport University offers practical, credit-bearing courses to help entry-level job seekers and incumbent workers gain the skills needed by airport employers.
- Port Jobs develops courses that are gateways to hospitality, transportation, and logistics careers in collaboration with employers, Highline Community College and the Seattle Community College District.

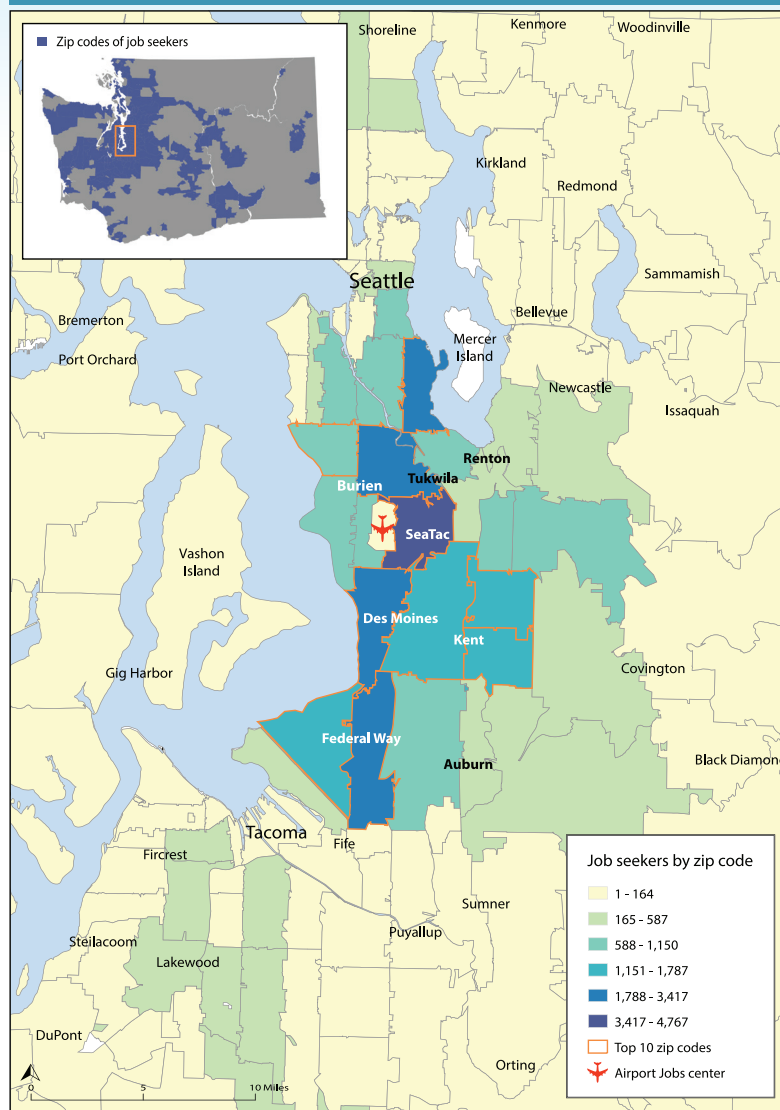
Apprenticeship Opportunities Project (AOP)
