10	on recognizing and responding to elder abuse, and			
11	WHEREAS, the Alzheimer's Association, a private organization with no			
12	contractual obligations with the county, has a vested interest in educating law			
13	enforcement on the serious issue of elder abuse, and			
14	WHEREAS, the Alzheimer's Association voluntarily, without coercion or			
15	inducement, wished to donate one thousand dollars to the Elder Abuse Conference, and			

16	WHEREAS, this donation will legitimately enhance the county's ability to serve		
17	in the public's interest and the knowledge gained at the conference by attendees will		
18	benefit the elderly throughout Washington state, and		
19	WHEREAS, this donation is intended neither to influence a particular county		
20	action, nor to affect the performance of official duties and responsibilities by the DJA
