Lead Priorities

- * Expand the Extended Foster Care Program to allow ALL youth aging out of foster care to have access to safe housing until age 21
- * Prevent **sibling visits** for youth in foster care from being restricted for inappropriate reasons
- * Reinstate the **72-hour notification** rule for homeless youth shelters working to serve vulnerable youth and safely reunite them with their families

Supporting Priorities

- * Ensuring youth have the opportunity to have their **juvenile records** sealed upon turning 18
- * Guarantee the **right to legal counsel** for youth in foster care
- * Improve Educational Outcomes for youth in foster Care
