*Ordinance 17726 enact a one-year moratorium commencing on December 16, 2013 that prohibits the location, establishment or expansion of any medical marijuana collective garden or medical marijuana dispensary in unincorporated King County, whether for profit or not-for-profit, asserted to be authorized or actually authorized under Chapter 181, Laws of 2011, and chapter 69.51A RCW. Ordinance 17726 was adopted by the Council on December 16, 2013. The public hearing on the moratorium is being held as required by the Growth Management Act, chapter 36.70A RCW.*
