In this meeting only the rules and procedures applicable to committees apply and not those applicable to full council meetings.

There are two ways to provide public comment:

1) In writing: You may comment in writing on agenda items by submitting your written comments to kcccowmeeting@gmail.com or by going to

If your comments are submitted before 10:00 a.m. on the day of the Committee of the Whole meeting, your comments will be distributed to the committee members and appropriate staff prior to the meeting.\

2) Orally during the meeting by phone: You may provide oral public comment during the meeting by calling into the committee meeting using the options provided below. You are not required to sign up in advance, but those who do so will be called on at the beginning of the comment period in
