7	SECTION 2. The metropolitan King County counci	l imposes the levies necessary	
8	to fund estimated expenditures for the year 2022 as listed in	this section. These amounts	
9	do not include the total of estimated revenues from sources of	other than taxation, including	
10	available surplus and such expenditures as are to be net from bond warrant issues. In		
11	accordance with state law, the King County assessor calculated a sum for property taxes
