Proposed No. FCD2022-02.1 **Sponsors** 1 A RESOLUTION of the Board of Supervisors of the King 2 County Flood Control Zone District authorizing retention 3 bonuses for District employees. 4 WHEREAS, since the beginning of the COVID-19 health emergency, many 5 employers have been impacted by what is termed "The Great Resignation." That refers to 6 the phenomenon of many employees resigning from their current positions to either seek 7 other employment or to at least temporarily absent themselves from the workforce, and 8 WHEREAS, an unstable workforce, characterized in part by an inordinate amount 9 of employee departures, can make it difficult to meet workplace demands, especially 10 during an ongoing health emergency, and 11 WHEREAS, in an effort to forestall critical departures from District employment, 12 it is advisable to enact one-time retention bonuses for all District employees; 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF 14 SUPERVISORS OF THE KING COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT: 15 <u>SECTION 1.</u> King County Flood Control Zone District employees, excluding 16 short-term temporary employees, administrative interns, elected officials, who are 17 employed by the District on January 31, 2021, and who remain employed by the District 18 through May 31, 2022, shall receive one-time retention bonuses equal to one and one half 19 percent of the employees' 2021 King County Flood Control Zone District wages reflected 20 on the employees' 2021 W-2 forms. If the employees continue to be employed by the

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21 King County Flood Control Zone District on December 30, 2022, the employees shall 22 receive one-time retention bonuses based on the employees' 2022 annual base salaries. 23 The bonus paid to an employee shall be one of the following: 24 A. A payment of four thousand dollars for employees whose 2022 base salaries 25 are less than one hundred thousand dollars; 26 B. A payment of two thousand dollars for employees whose 2022 base salaries 27 are greater than or equal to one hundred thousand dollars and less than or equal to one 28 hundred twenty five thousand dollars; or 29 C. A payment of one thousand dollars for employees whose 2022 base salaries 30 are greater than one hundred and twenty five thousand dollars.

- 31 SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after
- 32 its passage.
