SUMMARY

Proposed Motion 2010-0526 (pp. 3-5 of these materials) would authorize the Finance and Business Operations Division of the Department of Executive Services to accept donations in 2010 and 2011 from nonjudicial county elected officials in an amount sufficient to offset salary increases awarded to them by law in those years.

BACKGROUND

King County faces an estimated \$60 million budget deficit in 2011. In order to mitigate the effects of the deficit, most if not all of the county's nonjudicial elected officials have expressed an intention to forego the salary increase that they would otherwise be entitled to, by law, in 2010 and 2011. (The salaries of Superior Court and District Court judges have been frozen by law since 2008.)

Since the salaries of the county's nonjudicial elected officials are established by law, the only way those officials can forego their 2010 and 2011 salary increases is by donating the increases to the county. The county code provides that the procedure for county acceptance of donations of more than \$2,000 is by motion of the Council.²

PROPOSED MOTION 2010-0526

Proposed Motion 2010-0526 (pp. 3-5 of these materials) would authorize the Finance and Business Operations Division of the county's Department of Executive Services to accept the nonjudicial county elected officials' donations of their 2010 and 2011 salary increases.

¹ The county's nonjudicial elected officials comprise the Council, the Executive, the Prosecuting Attorney, the Sheriff, the Assessor, and the Director of Elections.

AMENDMENTS
