**Proposed No.** 2022-0145.2 **Sponsors** Dembowski 1 A MOTION related to the transfer of retired vanpool vans 2 to nonprofit organizations and local governments to meet 3 the needs of low-income, seniors or young people or people 4 with disabilities. 5 WHEREAS, King County provides transit services to its residents to increase 6 mobility options and reduce traffic congestion and related environmental degradation, 7 and 8 WHEREAS, the provision of passenger vans to nonprofit organizations and local 9 governments serving individuals with limited resources and mobility options can support 10 those goals and provide significant public benefits, and 11 WHEREAS, high-quality passenger vans retaining value and utility are 12 periodically retired from the county's vanpool program, and 13 WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council has previously transferred 14 retired vans to agencies serving low-income, seniors, disabled and young people, and 15 WHEREAS, K.C.C. 4.56.100 states that each year, "the Metro transit department 16 shall make available retired passenger vans for exclusive use by nonprofit organizations 17 or local governments that are able to address the mobility needs of low-income, seniors 18 or young people or people with disabilities," and 19 WHEREAS, in recognition of the operational, health and safety changes 20 organizations have made in response to the coronavirus disease 2019 emergency,
