1	AN ORDINANCE relating to plumbing and gas piping
2	permit fees authorized under K.C.C. 2.99.030; amending
3	Ordinance 6746, Section 10, as amended, and K.C.C.
4	16.32.080 and Ordinance 8330, Section 34, as amended,
5	and K.C.C. 16.32.085 and adding a new section to K.C.C.
6	chapter 16.32.
7	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
8	SECTION 1. A. Section 2 of this ordinance proposes changes in the fees
9	assessed related to permits under the plumbing code.
10	B. These fees are assessed under K.C.C. 2.99.030.
11	SECTION 2. Ordinance 6746, Section 10, as amended, and K.C.C. 16.32.080 are
12	each hereby amended to read as follows:
13	A. An applicant for a permit to do work under this code shall pay for each
14	plumbing permit, at the time of issuance, a fee in accordance with the following schedule,
15	and at the rate provided for each permit classification shown in the schedule:

96	D. If the work for which a permit fee has been paid is not started, the authority
97	having jurisdiction, upon proper application for refund and surrender of the permit for
98	cancellation, shall issue a refund. In determining the amount of refund due, the authority
99	having jurisdiction shall deduct the amount of the basic fee to cover the cost of
100	administration of the permit. A refund shall not be made for an expired permit.))
101	SECTION 3. A. Section 4 of this ordinance proposes changes in the fees
102	assessed related to permits under the plumbing code.
103	B. These fees are assessed under K.C.C. 2.99.030.
104	SECTION 4. Ordinance 8330, Section 34, as amended, and K.C.C. 16.32.085 are
105	each hereby amended to read as follows:
106	((Health department gas piping permit and inspection fees are as follows:))

123	((C. A reinspection fee of one hundred fifteen dollars may	v be assessed for each
124	inspection or reinspection when the portion of work for which ins	pection is called is not
125	complete or when corrections called for are not made. This subse	ction is not to be
126	interpreted as requiring inspection fees the first time a job is rejec	ted for failure to
127	comply with the requirements of this code, but as controlling the	practice of calling for
128	inspection or reinspection. Reinspection fees may be assessed wh	en the permit is not
129	properly posted on the work site, the work to be inspected is not u	nder test, for failure to
130	provide access on the date for which inspection is requested, or fo	r failure to make
131	required corrections. To obtain a reinspection the applicant shall	file an application for
132	the reinspection in writing upon a form furnished for that purpose	, and pay the
133	reinspection fee in accordance with this section. In instances whe	re reinspection fees

have been assessed, additional inspection of the work shall not be performed until the
 required fees have been paid.))

136 <u>SECTION 5.</u> A. Section 6 of this ordinance proposes fees for special services,
137 double permits and reinspection service under the plumbing code.

B. These fees are assessed under K.C.C. 2.99.030.

139 <u>NEW SECTION. SECTION 6.</u> There is hereby added a new section to K.C.C.
140 chapter 16.32 to read as follows:

A. Fees for inspection service outside regular working hours or for inspection
service requested but not covered by a permit will be charged at a rate equal to the cost of
performing the service.

B. Any person who commenced work for which a permit is required by this code 144 without first having obtained the permit shall upon subsequent application for the permit 145 pay double the applicable permit fee under this code, unless it is proved to the satisfaction 146 147 of the authority having jurisdiction that the work was urgently necessary, and that it was not practical to obtain a permit before the commencement of the work. In all such 148 149 emergency cases, a permit shall be obtained as soon as it is practical to do so, and if there 150 is an unreasonable delay in obtaining the permit then a double fee shall be charged as provided in this code. 151

152 C. A reinspection fee of one hundred thirty dollars may be assessed for each 153 inspection or reinspection if the portion of work under this code for which inspection is 154 called is not complete, or if corrections called for are not made. This subsection does not 155 require inspection fees the first time a job is rejected for failure to comply with this code. 156 Reinspection fees may be assessed if the permit is not properly posted on the work site, if

157 the work to be inspected is not under test, if the permit is for failure to provide access on 158 the date for which inspection is requested or for failure to make required corrections. Requests for reinspection shall be made in writing upon forms furnished for that purpose 159 160 and shall be accompanied by the reinspection fee in accordance with this section. If 161 reinspection fees have been assessed, then additional inspection of the work shall not be performed until the required fees have been paid. 162 D. If the work for which a permit fee has been paid under this code is not started, 163 then the authority having jurisdiction, upon proper application for refund and surrender of 164

the permit for cancellation, shall issue a refund. A refund may not be made for an

166 expired permit.

SECTION 7. This ordinance takes effect January 1, 2011.
