## AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2022-0235, VERSION 1

- 2 On page 1, beginning on line 19, strike lines 19 through 21, and insert:
- 3 "D. Under current state law, there are six different types of protection orders
- 4 codified separately to provide an order for protection for vulnerable adults and people
- 5 experiencing domestic violence, harassment, sexual assault, stalking and other extreme
- 6 risk. Petitions for relief under those protection orders are processed by judicial officers
- depending on their authority. Effective July 1, 2022, under a new chapter of state law,
- 8 Chapter 215, Laws of Washington 2021, all protection orders will be consolidated and
- 9 harmonized, along with judicial authority for commissioners to provide relief for all
- 10 protection orders.
- E. RCW 7.105.580 authorizes superior court to appoint attorneys to act as
- 12 protection order commissioners and exercise all powers and perform all duties of an
- appointed court commissioner. That authority must be consented to by the county
- 14 legislative authority before creating the positions and being implemented by superior
- 15 court.
- F. Unless given authorization by the council, after July 1, 2022, statutory
- commissioners will only be authorized to hear domestic violence protections orders. The
- 18 remaining types of protection orders must be heard by constitutional commissioners and

19	judges. If this ordinance does not take effect by July 1, 2022, there will likely be an
20	increase in protection order processing time if petitioners qualify for a protection order
21	that does not match the order they filed for.
22	G. It is necessary for this ordinance to take effect immediately to preserve public
23	peace, health, safety and support county government, as RCW 7.105.580 takes effect July
24	1, 2022, and allow any family law, mental health or criminal commissioner in King
25	County superior court to evaluate petitioner claims and provide the applicable protection
26	order in compliance with state law."
