As a SEPA official within the Permitting Division of the Department of Local Services, I was tasked with performing the SEPA review and threshold determination under SEPA for the proposed code amendments related to financial coverage for proposed Fossil Fuel Facilities and Non-Hydroelectric Generation Facilities.

As part of that process, I reviewed the checklist, proposed ordinance, existing codes, regulations and policies.

A DNS was issued and published on March 30, 2022, with a comment period ending April 22, 2022. No substantive public comment was received. A subsequent SEPA Addendum to the DNS was issued after consideration of additional potential related code amendments.

No further action as it relates to this SEPA review and the DNS is necessary at this time.
