As a SEPA official within the Permitting Division of the Department of Local Services, I was tasked with performing the SEPA review and threshold determination under SEPA for the proposed code amendments related to amendments to the Public Benefit Rating System current use assessment program.

As part of that process, I reviewed the checklist, proposed ordinance, existing codes, regulations and policies.

A DNS was issued and published on September 14, 2022, with a comment period ending October 4, 2022. No public comment was received. Therefore, no further action as it related to this SEPA review and the DNS is necessary at this time.
