Proposed No. 2022-0380.1 **Sponsors** McDermott 1 AN ORDINANCE eliminating electronic monitoring fees 2 for all program participants; and repealing Ordinance 3 12917, Section 1, as amended, and K.C.C. 4A.640.010. 4 PREAMBLE: 5 King County's department of adult and juvenile detention through its 6 community corrections division manages an electronic monitoring 7 program as an alternative to secure detention. Program participants are 8 required to pay fees for monitoring and equipment rental pursuant to 9 K.C.C. 4A.640.010. Such fees can impact a person's ability to participate 10 in the program. The executive removed the fee requirements throughout 11 the COVID-19 pandemic in order to make the program accessible to 12 everyone, regardless of their ability to pay. This ordinance removes the 13 fee requirements for the program permanently.
