## STRIKING AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2011-0046, VERSION

- A. The council finds that it is beneficial and efficient for the full council to consider and act on labor policies and that it is most appropriate that final action on such
- 8 policies take place during a council meeting.
  - B. The council further finds that it shall be beneficial and efficient for the duties of the labor implementation committee under this chapter to be performed by the various council standing committees, with respect to those bargaining units whose employees' functions are within the substantive policy area assigned to the standing committee
- pursuant to council motion.
  - C. Consistent with the county charter, the council adopts motions related to the organization and administration of the council, including but not limited to the duties of the council and its standing committees.
