1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2022-0439, VERSION 2**

2 On page 2, line 22, after "SECTION 2." insert:

3 "A."

4 On page 3, after line 23, insert:

5 "B. For the duration of the interlocal agreement, the executive must report
6 quarterly to the King County council on the performance of jail services provided for
7 King County by South Correctional Entity. Reports may be electronically transmitted to
8 the clerk of the council who shall retain an electronic copy and provide an electronic
9 copy to all councilmembers, the council chief of staff and the lead staff for the law,
10 justice, health and human services committee, or its successor. Alternatively, reports
11 may be provided via written and oral briefing to the law, justice, health and human
12 services committee, or its successor. To the extent practically feasible, each report
13 should include information from the quarter before the report date, including, but not
14 limited to:

- 15 1. The number of King County inmates that were:
- 16 a. booked into South Correctional Entity;
- 17 b. housed by South Correctional Entity;
- 18 c. transported by South Correctional Entity; and

- 19 d. transported by the department of adult and juvenile detention to or from
20 South Correctional Entity;
- 21 2. The average length of stay of King County inmates housed at South
22 Correctional Entity;
- 23 3. The status of King County inmates housed at South Correctional Entity's
24 access to:
- 25 a. court appearances;
- 26 b. in-person programming;
- 27 c. video visitation; and
- 28 d. timely release;
- 29 4. A listing of all infractions by and resulting disciplinary actions against King
30 County inmates housed at South Correctional Entity;
- 31 5. Consultation with representatives of the department of adult and juvenile
32 detention, the department of public defense, King County Corrections Guild, superior
33 court, the prosecuting attorney's office, South Correctional Entity and other stakeholders
34 and a discussion of any concerns raised about jail services provided by South
35 Correctional Entity on behalf of King County inmates by stakeholders; and
- 36 6. The status of South Correctional Entity's professional accreditations."
