Policy Alignment

- **Strategic Plan:** "Metro will work with partners to improve public transportation and increase transit use...Partnerships can range from implementation of transit-supportive land use policies to speed and reliability improvements to direct funding of services."
- Metro Connects: "Metro cannot achieve Metro Connects all at once or do it alone. Collaboration, partnerships, continuous improvement, and demonstration of value will be key."
- 2020 Strategic Climate Action Plan: "Build Partnerships" is identified as one of the nine SCAP guiding principles.



Capital Project Partnership Process


Opportunities – Identify future capital investments



Success: Tukwila/Metro Permitting Partnership




Metro & City Of Tukwila Negotiating Interagency Agreement to Expedite Permitting

- Limited to select high priority project
- Expedited turnaround from consultant reviewers for city
- Pre-reviews with Metro to understand unique infrastructure and equipment

Success: Bellevue College Connector

- The vision is a new transit connection through campus on Snoqualmie River Road
- Timeline:
 - Bellevue Transit Master Plan (2014)
 - Bellevue College Master Plan (2017)
 - Metro Connects (2017)
 - Design concepts (2020)
 - Design 30 percent (2022)
- Added benefit to K Line
