## METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF ADOPTION Ordinance 19601

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing on Tuesday, May 2, 2023, beginning at 1:30 PM to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2023-0092 (Ordinance 19601) an ordinance adopting regulations for fossil fuel facilities and non-hydroelectric generation facilities. The Council adopted this Ordinance at the Tuesday, May 2, 2023, meeting.

The Ordinance modifies requirements for fossil fuel facilities and non-hydro-electric generation facilities, as those terms are defined in King County Code Title 21A.

For privately owned fossil fuel facilities and for privately owned non-hydroelectric generation facilities not accessory to waste management processes, the Ordinance:

the Ordinance:

Requires the facility to demonstrate financial responsibility in an amount necessary to compensate for the maximum damages from an explosion resulting from a worst-case release;

Requires the facility to demonstrate financial responsibility in an amount necessary to compensate for facility decommissioning;

Sets standards for the explosion study and decommissioning study necessary to determine the adequate level of financial responsibility; and

Requires the level of financial responsibility to be reviewed for adequacy every five years.

The Ordinance also requires non-hydro-electric generation facilities not accessory to waste management processes to undergo a five-year review of all permit conditions. This review is already required of fossil fuel facilities.
