1		AN ORDINANCE d	lissolving the King County Economic
2		Enterprise Corporati	on; and repealing Ordinance 6628,
3		Sections 1 through 1	0 and K.C.C. 2.32.210.
4		STATEMENT OF FACTS:	
5		1. On January 3, 1984, the	council passed Ordinance 6628 creating the
6		King County Economic Ent	erprise Corporation, a public corporation, to
7		issue industrial revenue bon	ds for the purpose of fostering economic
8		development in King Count	y.
9		2. Sixteen industrial revenu	e bonds were issued by the King County
10		Economic Enterprise Corpo	ration and all sixteen have been retired.
11		3. The King County Econor	mic Enterprise Corporation has no outstanding
12		obligations and no property	to administer other than \$95,221 in assets.
13		4. A public corporation crea	ated by a municipality pursuant to RCW
14		39.84.030, may be dissolved	by the municipality if the public corporation
15		has no property to administe	er, other than funds or property, if any, to be
16		paid or transferred to the mu	unicipality by which it was established; and all
17		its outstanding obligations h	ave been satisfied.
18		5. RCW 39.84.030 requires	the governing body of the municipality to
19		adopt an ordinance in order	to dissolve a public corporation.

20	6. In 1990 the Washington state Legislature created the Washington	
21	Economic Development Finance Authority, an independent agency within	
22	the executive branch of state government, to issue nonrecourse bonds,	
23	including industrial revenue bonds, throughout the state.	
24	7. Dissolution of the King County Economic Enterprise Corporation will	
25	reduce duplicative county efforts while still providing the services	
26	contemplated by Ordinance 6628.	
27	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:	
28	SECTION 1. The King County Economic Enterprise Corporation, a public	
29	corporation created by King County Ordinance 6628, is hereby dissolved.	
30	SECTION 2. Pursuant to RCW 39.84.030, upon dissolution all of the assets of	
31	the King County Economic Enterprise Corporation, including any funds held by a	
32	financial institution, shall vest in King County and shall be transferred or paid to King	
33	County.	

34 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Ordinance 6628, Sections 1 through 10, and K.C.C. 2.32.210 are each hereby repealed.
