Eastgate, SE Newport Way, Factoria, and Downtown Bellevue


SERVICE CHANGE:

Implement new Route 241 be ween the Erstgate Park-and-Ride and the Bellevue Transit Center via SE Vewport Way, Factoria, South Bellevue Park-and-Ride, and 112th Avenue SE.

On weekdays and between approximately 5:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. and on Saturdays between approximately 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., operate Route 241 every 30 minutes; during evening hours until approximately 10:00 p.m. and on Sundays between approximately 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m., operate Route 241 every 60 minutes

Route 241 will provide replacement service for portions of Route 222 between the South Bell vue Park-and-Ride and the Eastgate Park-and-Ride via Factoria.

Discontinue Route 222 and implement Route 241 in October 2011.



OBJECTIVES:

Improve transit service to population and employment concentrations along 112th Avenue SE in Bellevue, and use resources more intensively. (Strategy S-2, Improve Service Design, and Strategy S-3, Cire Service Connections, Strategic Plan for Public Transportation Strategic Plan for Public Transportation, 2008-2017).

IMPACTED SERVICE AREA:

Bellevue and Clyde Hill

SERVICE CHANGE:

Revise Route 240 between South Bollevue Park-and-Ride and the Bellevue Transit Center to serve 112th Avenue XE.

Replacement service along 108 Avenue SE in the Surrey Downs neighborhood will be provided by Route 249.

Replacement service between the Bellevue Transit Center and Clyde Hill will be provided by Route 246

Implement the Route 240 changes in October 2011.

Revise to operate on NE 40th Street between Bel-Red Road and West Lake Sammamish Parkway NE, and on 152nd Avenue NE between NE 24th Street and the NE 36th Street Bridge.


In Overlake, revise to serve 152nd A enue NE, the new NE 36th Street Bridge over SR-520, NE 36th Street, 148th Avenue NE, NE 29th Place, NE 24th Street, and 140th Avenue NE.

Revise to serve the South Kirkland Part-and-Ride with all trips in both directions and to serve Bellevue Way N.E.

South of downtown Bellevue revise to connect the Bellevue Transit Center and the South Bellevue Park and-Ride via 108th Avenue SE (north of Bellevue Way SE) and Enami and Beaux Arts (south of SE 10th Street).

On weekdays, improve the service frequency to operate every 30 minutes between approximately 5:00 a.m. and 7:30 p.m.; add service on Sundays operating every 60 minutes between approximately 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Implement the Route 249 revisions in October 2011.


Eastgate, SE Newport Way, Factoria, <u>Surrey Downs</u> and Downtown Bellevue SERVICE CHANGE:


