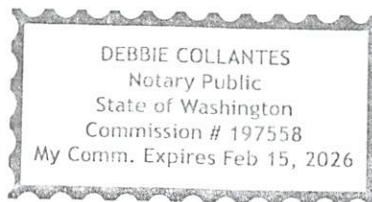

Anyone needing a physical space to attend the remote hearing may walk into the King County Courthouse at 516 Third Avenue, Seattle, Washington (Third Avenue between Yesler and James). Check-in at the front desk on the 12th floor. Staff will seat you in front of a video screen where you can observe the hearing and offer public comment. Please allow sufficient time in advance of the hearing start time to navigate traffic, find parking in busy downtown, and to move through Courthouse security. Note that animals are not allowed at the hearing location.

Any member of the public wanting to submit written statements or other documents should email those to hearingexaminer@kingcounty.gov by 4:00 p.m. September 6, 2024. If you would like to provide testimony at the hearing, please email the Hearing Examiner's Office ahead of time with your contact information.

The area to be vacated is described as follows: That portion of 200TH Ave SE (J.E. Carroll Rd., County Road No. 2677), as deeded to King County by Recording No. 2842420, lying within the North 150 feet of the Northwest Quarter of Section 20, Township 23 North, Range 6 East, W.M., Said North 150 feet otherwise referred to as Lots 55, 56 & 57 of Lake McDonald Waterfront Tracts (Unrecorded). Situate in King County, Washington

The adjacent parcels are zoned RA-5.
