WHEREAS, the council has determined that the prosecuting attorney's office has responded satisfactorily to the proviso;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
The proviso response is hereby adopted and the $\$ 150,000$ currently held in
reserve in Ordinance 16984, Section 29, Proviso P1, prosecuting attorney office, is hereby released.
