NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the Metropoliton King County Council, Room 1001, King County Council, Council, Room 1001, King County County of Unit of the Council of the Intervent of the maratorium, declared a one-vear moratorium on the establishment or location of medical marijuana dispensaries and collective gardens asserted to be an actually outhorized under Chapter 181, Lows of Washington 2011, and chapter 69,51A RCW and required the county executive to transmit within six months a work plan that sets a timeline for the review of (1) the impacts of existing medical marijuana alsoensaries and Washington state Liquor Control Board licensed recreational marijuana businesses in unincarporated King County: (2) proposed or adopted state legislation intended to address the interaction between Chapter 181, Lows of Washington state Initiative Measure No. 502; and (3) whether adoption of an appropriate land use regulation would address the impacts and concerns identified in section 1 of Ordinance 17726 and the work plan.

Ordinance 17726 was adopted on December 16, 2013. A public hearing within sixty days of the enactment of a moratorium and the adoption of findings is required by RCW 36.70A.390. The public hearing noticed herein satisfies this statutory requirement.
