*Update County Code language to be con-sistent with the state and model codes and address changes to International Code numbering.

Madify building codes for residential buildings which house either couportions or home industries, to provide additional flexibility to home businesses without presenting ony public health or safety concerns.

•Exempt from building permit requirements installation of rapt-mounted solar panets that meet specified loading standards and smaller wind turbines.

The proposed amendments also repeal several King County amendments to the building, fire, and plumbing codes that are now covered by the International and Uniform codes.
