Proposed Ordinance 2014-0187 would make significant changes to existing regulations for for-hire transportation companies, including taxicobs, for-hire vehicles, and adding Transportation Network Companies, in three primary areas: (1) add new regulations affecting Transportation Network Company organizations, drivers, and vehicles; (2) make ather changes to regulations that affect toxicab, for-hire, and Transportation Network Company organizations; and, (3) other modifications to county code to streamline and update existing regulations. In addition, Proposed Ordinance 2014-0187 would amend King County Code provisions that currently establish a variety of code violations as civil infractions (punishable with a fine) or misdemeanors (punishable with iail and/ or fine). This ordinance proposes to narrow the number of violations that would quality as infractions or misdemeanors. In essence, an initial violation of code would be an infraction; with a subsequent offense being a misdemeanor.
