1	AN ORDINANCE relating to transportation
2	concurrency; and amending Ordinance 14050,
3	Section 14, as amended, and K.C.C. 14.70.270.
4	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
5	SECTION 1. Ordinance 14050, Section 14, as amended, and K.C.C. 14.70.270
6	are each hereby amended to read as follows:
7	A. The concurrency map shall be <u>reviewed and</u> updated ((annually as part of the
8	budget process)) in even-numbered years or when ((authorized)) directed by the
9	((county)) council ((by ordinance)) by motion. The update process shall ((include))
10	reflect the most recently adopted roads CIP, updated traffic volumes and updated travel
11	time surveys and standards and methodologies as described in K.C.C. 14.70.220 and
12	14.70.230. If the update requires changes in the concurrency map, ((Ŧ))the new
13	concurrency map shall be submitted to council for its approval by ordinance no later than
14	July 31, together with the reports required in subsections B. and C. of this section. The
15	((updates)) approved map shall be deemed adequate for the purposes of concurrency
16	analysis and ((the concurrency map))shall be used to determine the concurrency of
17	proposed development projects.
18	B. ((An annual report shall be prepared by t))The roads services division shall
19	prepare a report on the concurrency program update for submission to the council by July

20	31, together with any ordinance required by subsection A. of this section. The ((annual))
21	report shall explain the technical assumptions, land use changes, network changes and
22	other parameters used to update the concurrency map $and((-)$ travel shed boundary
23	map. ((The annual report shall be submitted to the council along with the annual update
24	required by subsection A. of this section. A paper copy and an electronic copy of the
25	report shall be filed with the clerk of the council, who shall retain the paper original and
26	shall forward electronic copies to each councilmember and to the lead staff of the
27	council's transportation, economy and environment committee, or its successor.))
28	C.1. An independent expert review panel on concurrency shall be established to:
29	a. review the ((annual)) report on the concurrency update; and
30	b. evaluate proposed changes to the transportation concurrency process,
31	analysis and test developed by the road services division.
32	2. The panel shall be comprised of four to six persons and include representation
33	from the development community, the environmental community, transportation planning
34	professionals, the unincorporated area, the public at large and multimodal transportation
35	interest groups. Each representative shall be appointed by the executive and confirmed
36	by the council.
37	3. A summary of the panel's review of the ((annual)) report on the concurrency
38	update and its evaluation of proposed changes to the transportation concurrency process,
39	analysis and test shall be included with the submittal of the ((annual)) report ((to the
40	council)) required by subsection B. of this section.
41	D. ((The concurrency map is a result of the concurrency analysis and test, as
42	described in subsection A. of this section. The concurrency map indicates if an area does

- 43 or does not comply with adopted level of service standards.)) Any changes to the
- 44 concurrency status of an area or areas on the concurrency map other than those resulting
- 45 from the update process may only be accomplished by the council, through an ordinance,
- 46 by changing any combination of the adopted level of service standards($(_{5})$) or the list of
- 47 funded projects in the most recently adopted CIP.
