1		AN ORDINANCE approving the	ne Union Hill Water
2		Association's Comprehensive W	Vater System Plan.
3		STATEMENT OF FACTS:	
4		1. King County has adopted K.C.C. ch	apter 13.24, which requires
5		approval of comprehensive plans for w	ater and sewer utilities that provide
6		service in unincorporated King County	as a prerequisite for operating in
7		unincorporated King County, receiving	approval for annexation proposals,
8		being granted right of way franchises, a	and being given approval for right
9		of way construction permits. K.C.C. ch	napter 13.24 prescribes the
10		requirements for approval of such plans	s, including consistency with state
11		and local planning requirements.	
12		2. The Union Hill water association's la	ast comprehensive plan was
13		prepared in 2005. Washington state De	epartment of Health and King
14		County regulations require water plans	to be updated every six years.
15		3. The Union Hill service area is within	n King County and the Union Hill
16		Water Association has adopted a compr	rehensive plan update ("the plan").
17		4. King County has adopted a Compre	hensive Plan that includes policies
18		F-101 through F-254, the applicable po	rtions of which address water

policies for facilities and services; these water policies call for consistency

20	with other adopted plans, pursuit of reclaimed water, water conservation
21	and protection of water resources.
22	5. K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires the utilities technical review committee
23	to review and make a recommendation to the King County executive and
24	council on the plan, the requirements under K.C.C. chapter 13.24 and
25	consistency with the King County Comprehensive Plan. The utilities
26	technical review committee has reviewed the planning data and system
27	operations and has found:
28	a. The plan uses population and employment forecasts developed by the
29	Puget Sound Regional Council and acknowledges the service area is rural;
30	b. The system's service area is in unincorporated King County;
31	c. The capital facility plan is adequate to meet anticipated facility and
32	service needs;
33	d. The plan is consistent with applicable Washington state water quality
34	laws; and
35	e. The plan is consistent with other pertinent county adopted plans and
36	policies.
37	6. Washington state Department of Health approval is pending upon King
38	County's approval of the plan.
39	7. Under the state Environmental Policy Act the Union Hill Water
40	Association completed an environmental check list and King County
41	issued a Determination of Nonsignificance for the plan approval on
42	January 13, 2015. There were no appeals.

13	8. The Union Hill Water Association's operations and facilities meet
14	multiple existing statutory, administrative and planning standards. As the
15	Union Hill Water Association's operations, facilities and planning meet
16	the requirements of the King County Code and are consistent with the
17	King County Comprehensive Plan, the utilities technical review
18	committee has recommended approval of the plan.
19	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
50	SECTION 1. The Union Hill Water Association Comprehensive Water System

- Plan, Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved as a comprehensive water
- 52 system plan.
